SFEDI Awards Level 7 Diploma In Business Management (OCF).

Course Summary

This qualification is designed to give learners a good understanding of the responsibilities of a manager and the techniques they will use to deal with different situations as well as the legal, social requirements within their role. It is credit transfer to an MBA at British Universities.

Students will be required to review their previous knowledge gained at lower levels and former employment by incorporating a graduate approach of analysis and evaluation.

Entry requirements: English language average equivalent to European frame work B2. Students will need a relevant degree to study this qualification. Students who have completed YVS programme, sfedi award or other ofqual approved Level 6 Business Management programme will also be eligible for taking this programme. We also consider mature entry route for applications from individuals over the age of 21 with 3 years management experience with no first degree.

Starting Dates

We have flexible starting dates. Centre will decide the start and end date of learners.

Examination

There will be no end of course examinations by YVS, however centres will be required to have learners take a time limited progression task. Student progression as per centre decision, which will be number of assessment methods.

Potential Jobs

Students completing this course will usually work in Management or Administrative roles managing staff in a variety of different scenarios from small to large businesses.

Assessment

Total Credit for the course is available with minimum 428 guided learning hours.

Students will need to pass six mandatory and two optional units to gain the qualification.

This will include Centre examination, case study, class activities, seminars or workshop or presentation or assignments.

External Moderation

This will be undertaken by YVS External Examiners at the centre during the course. In order to assist centres this will take place at an early stage as well as the end of the course.

British University will accept students onto an MBA programme with credit transfer.
